The top three industries in 2024 are State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Federal Government, Civilian, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

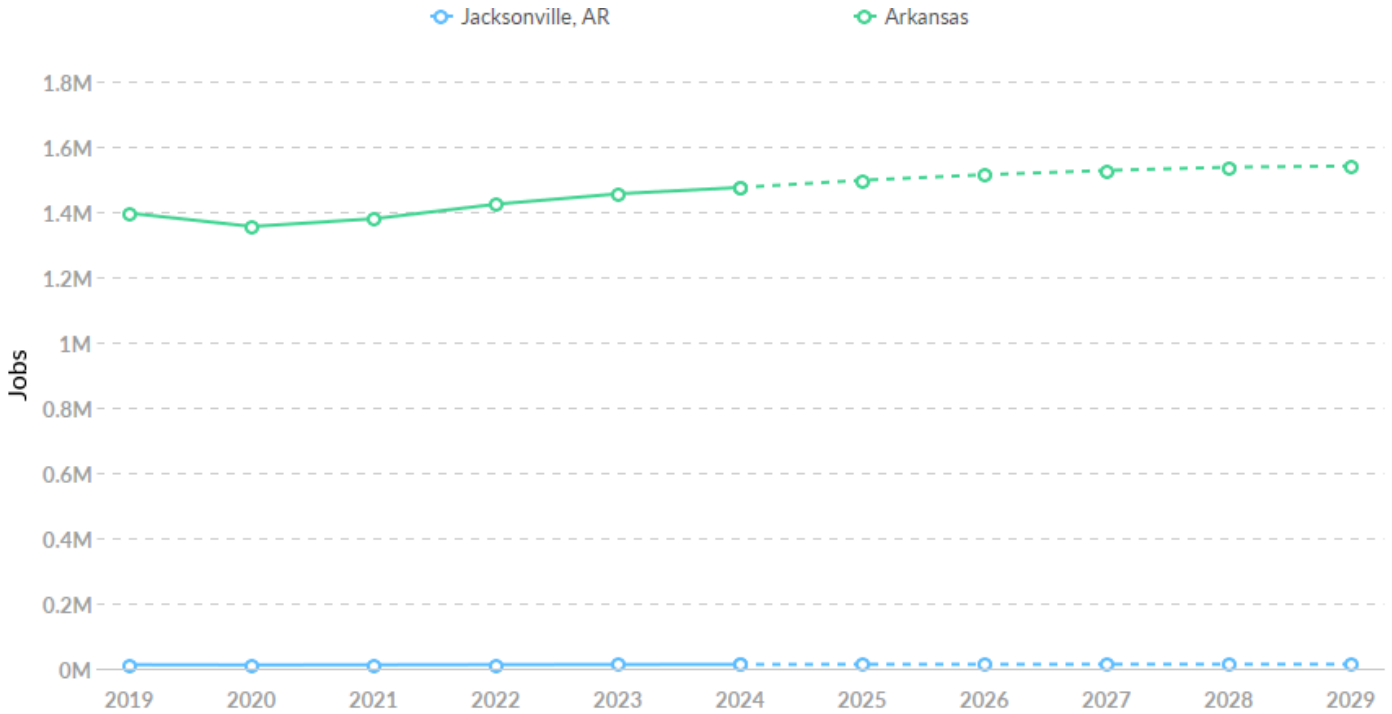
### Projected Employment Growth

## Job Trends

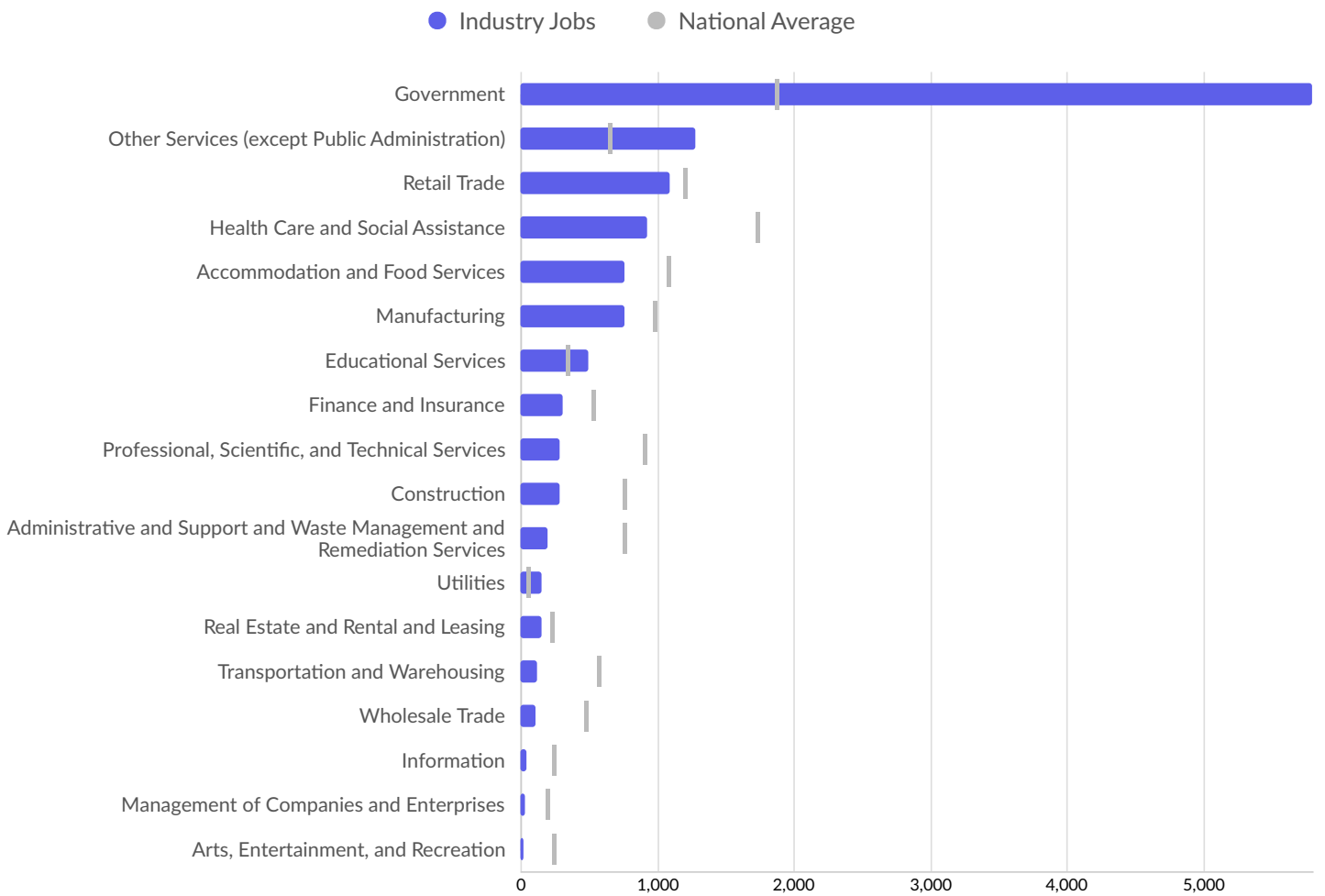

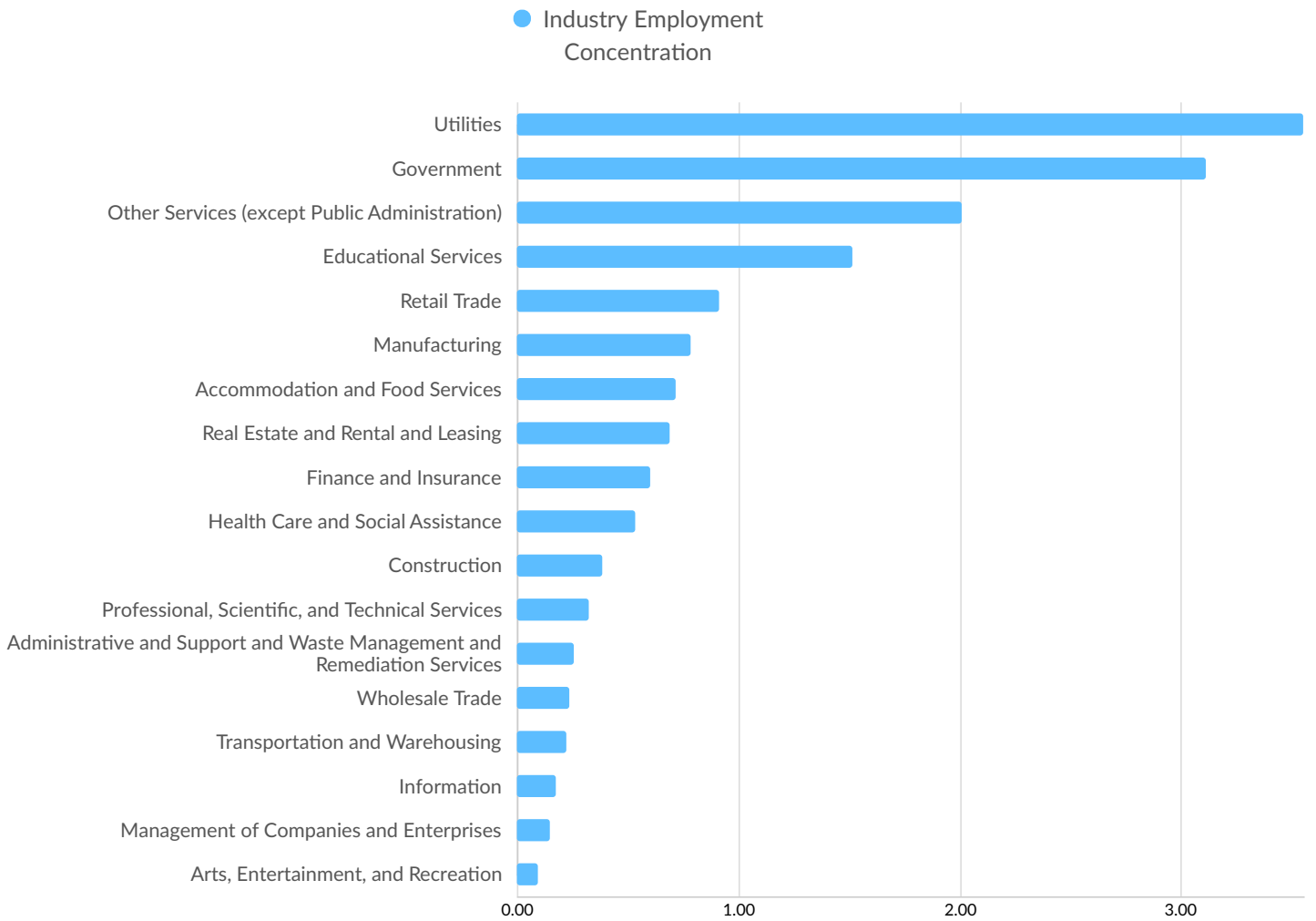

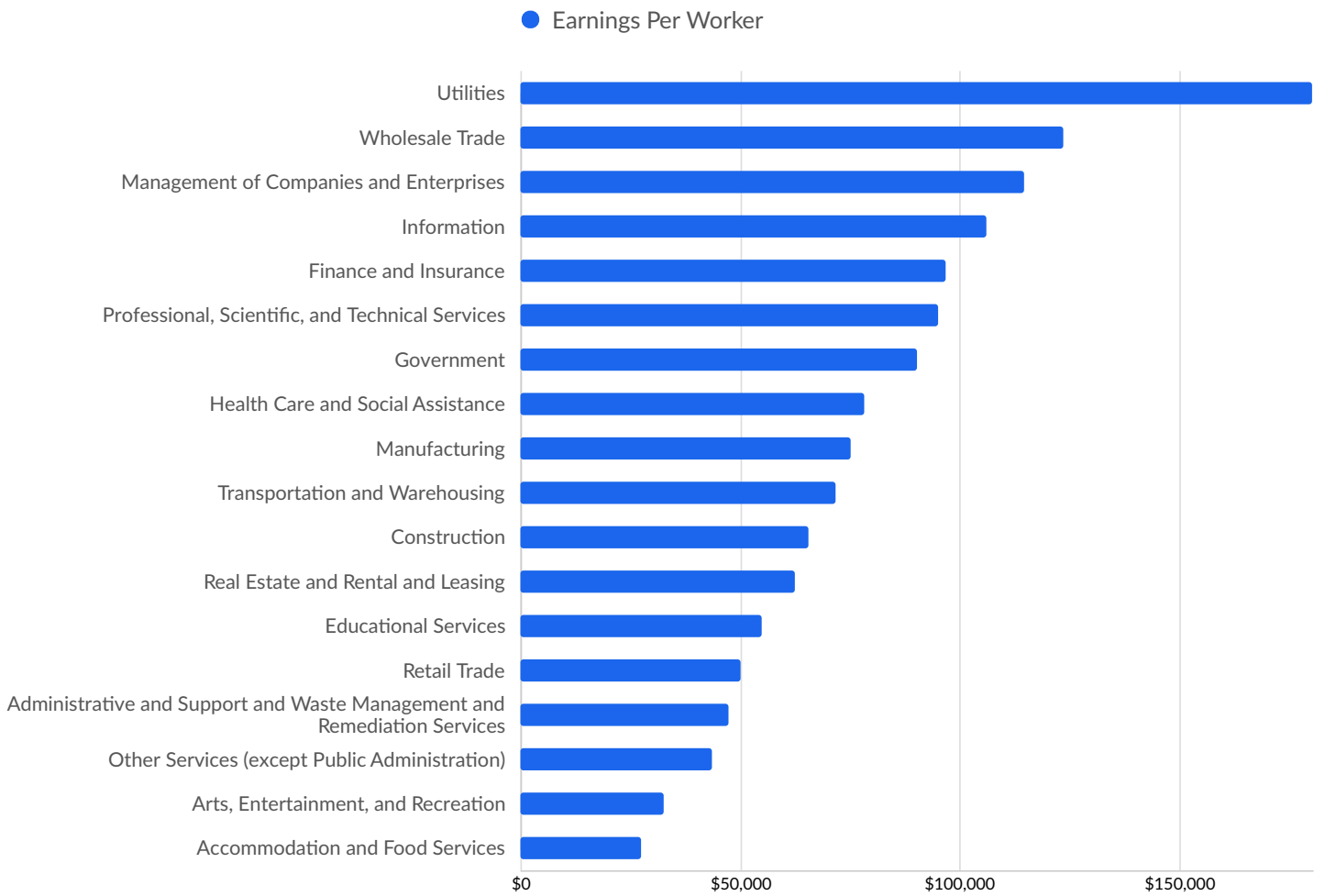

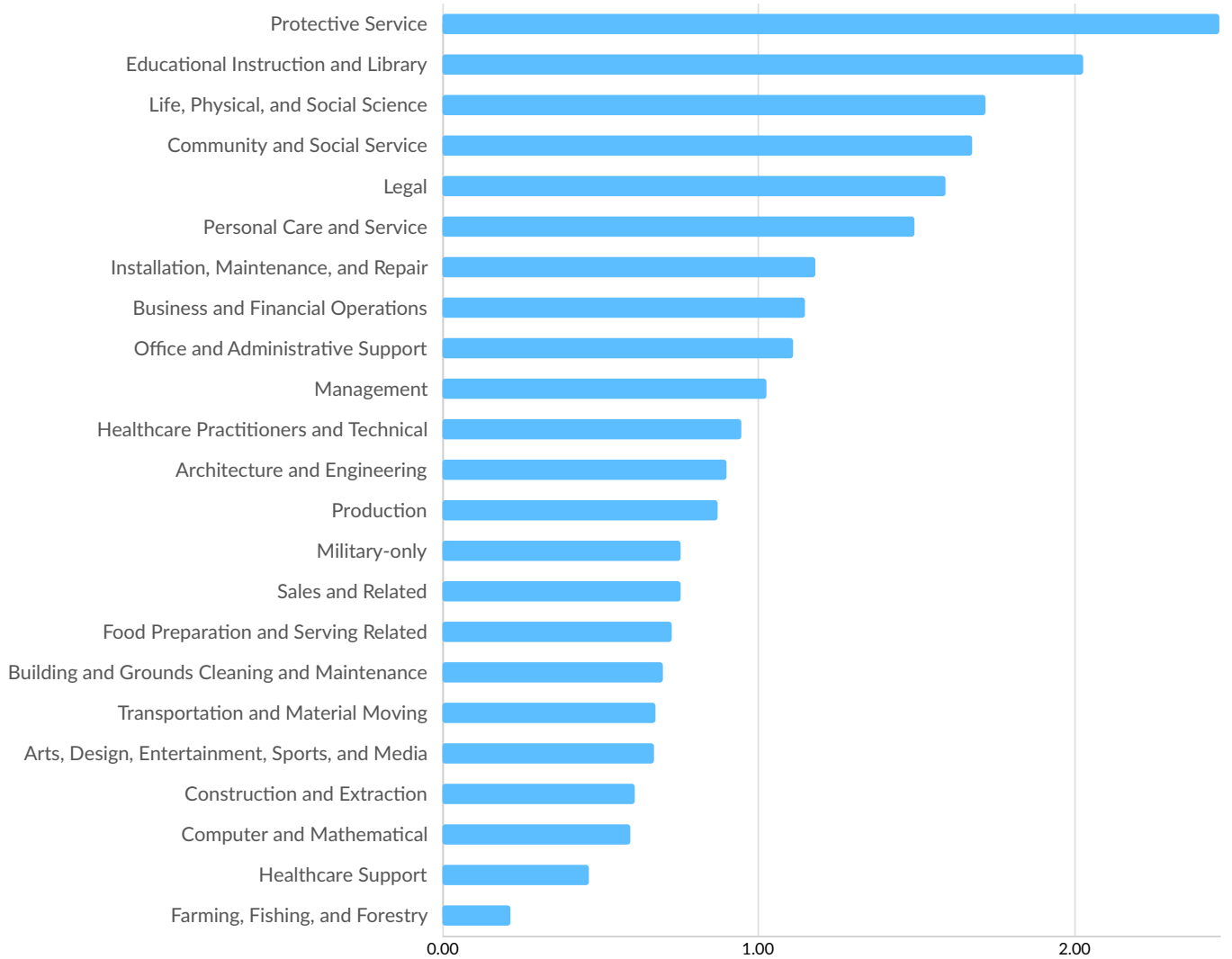

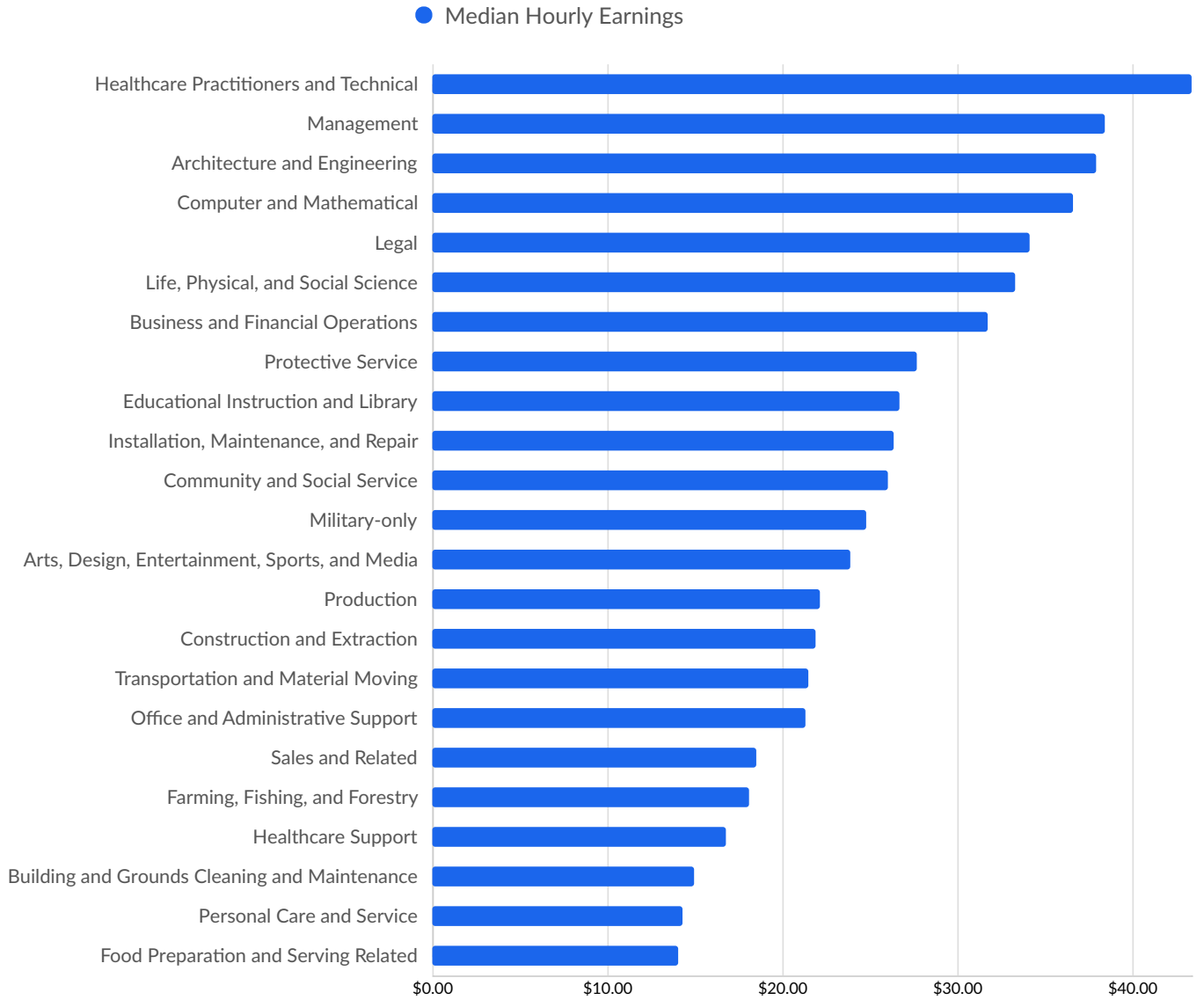


## Top Occupation Employment Concentration

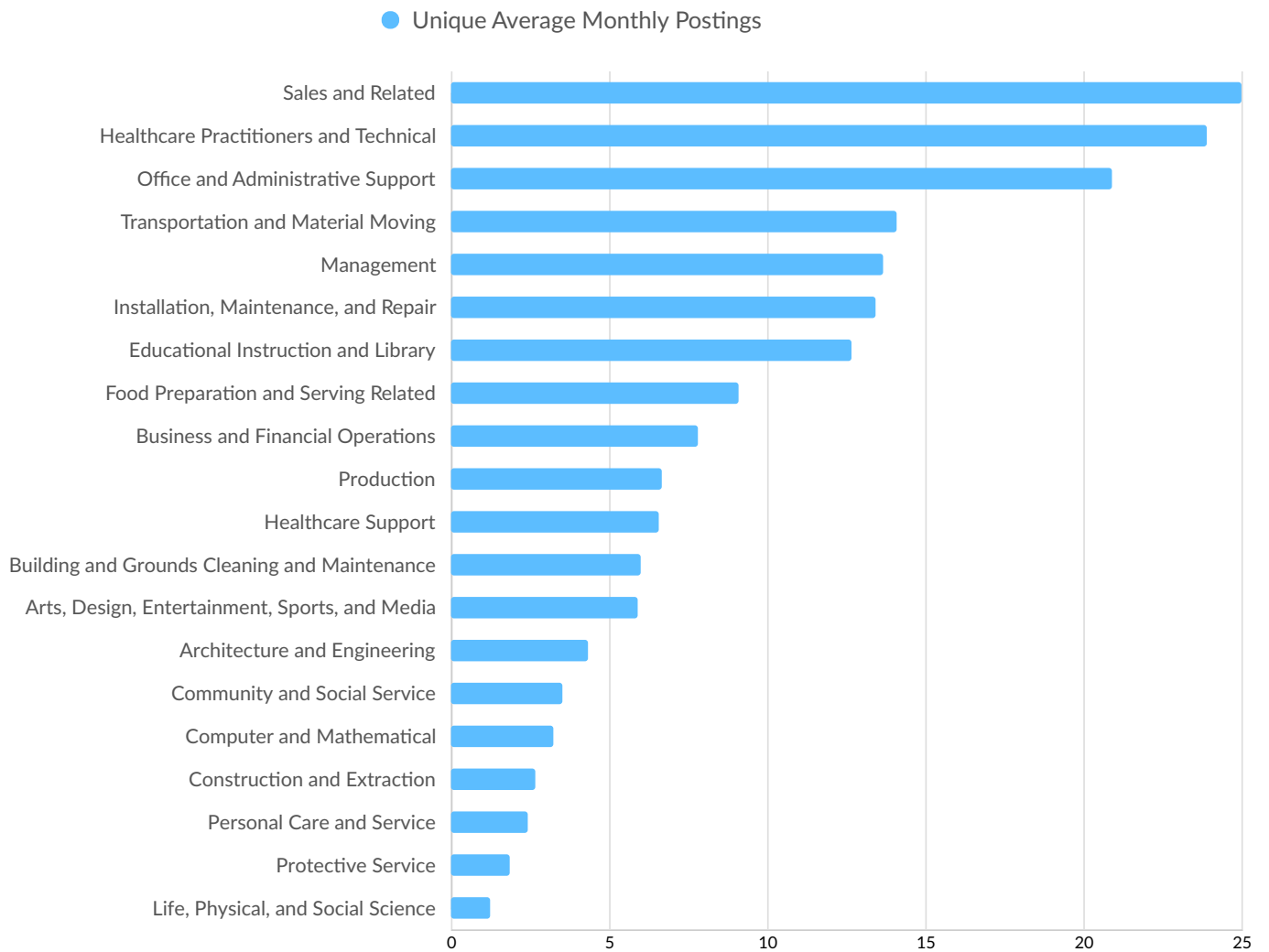

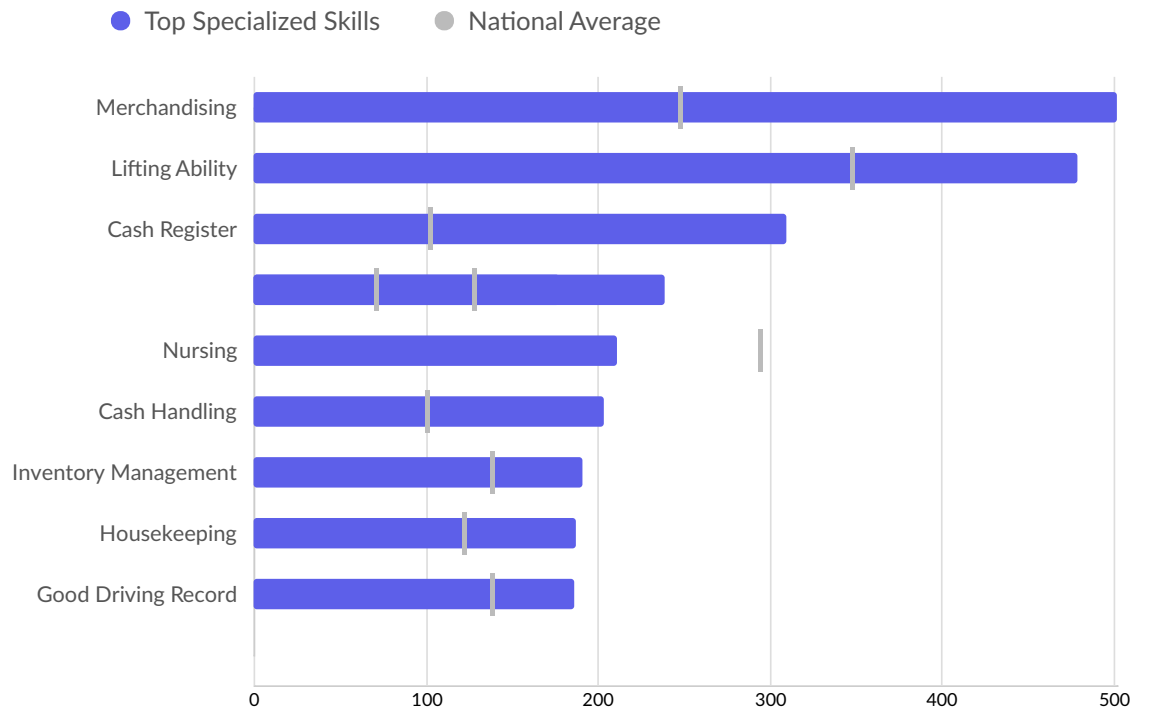

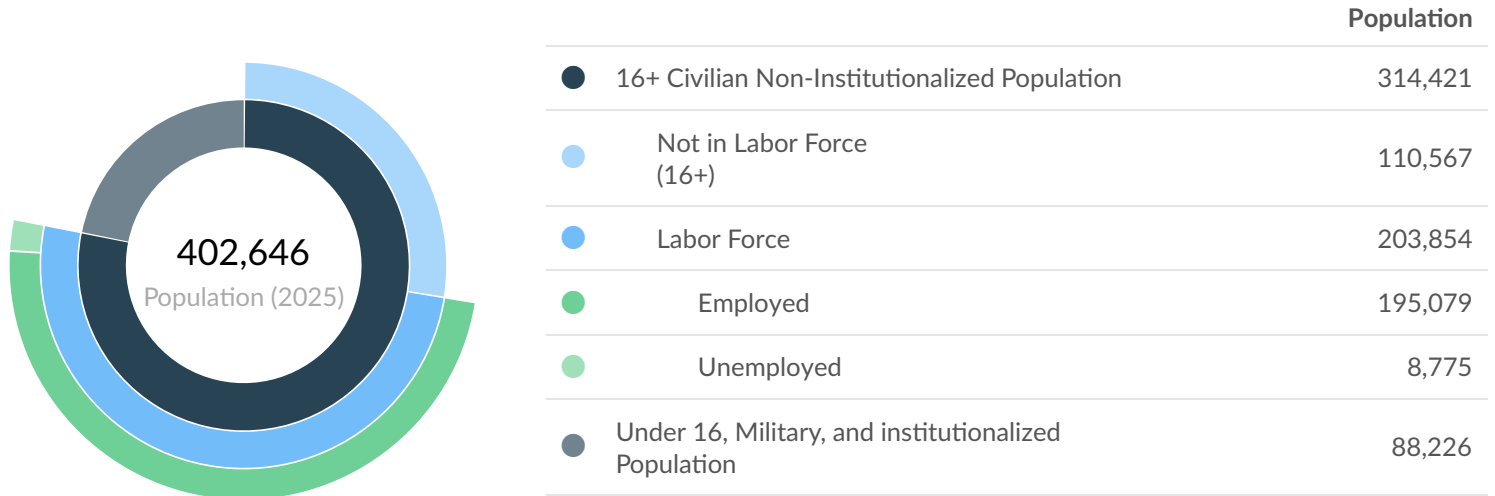
## County Level Roll-up Details

## Sep 2025 Labor Force Breakdown

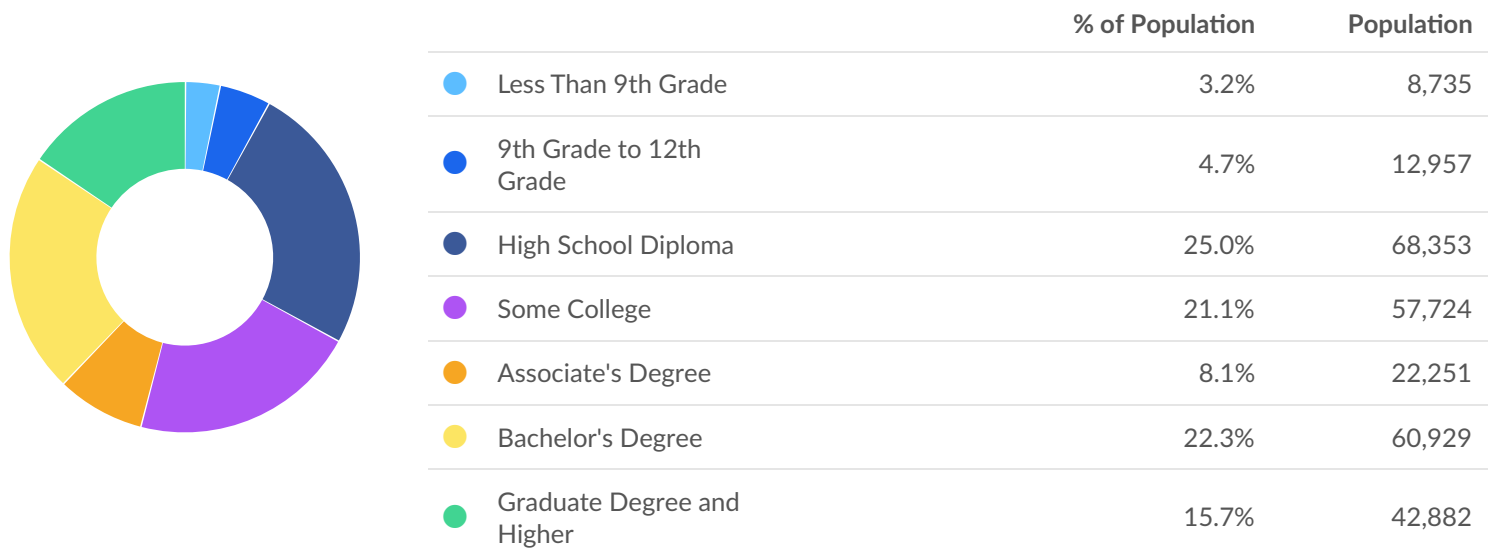

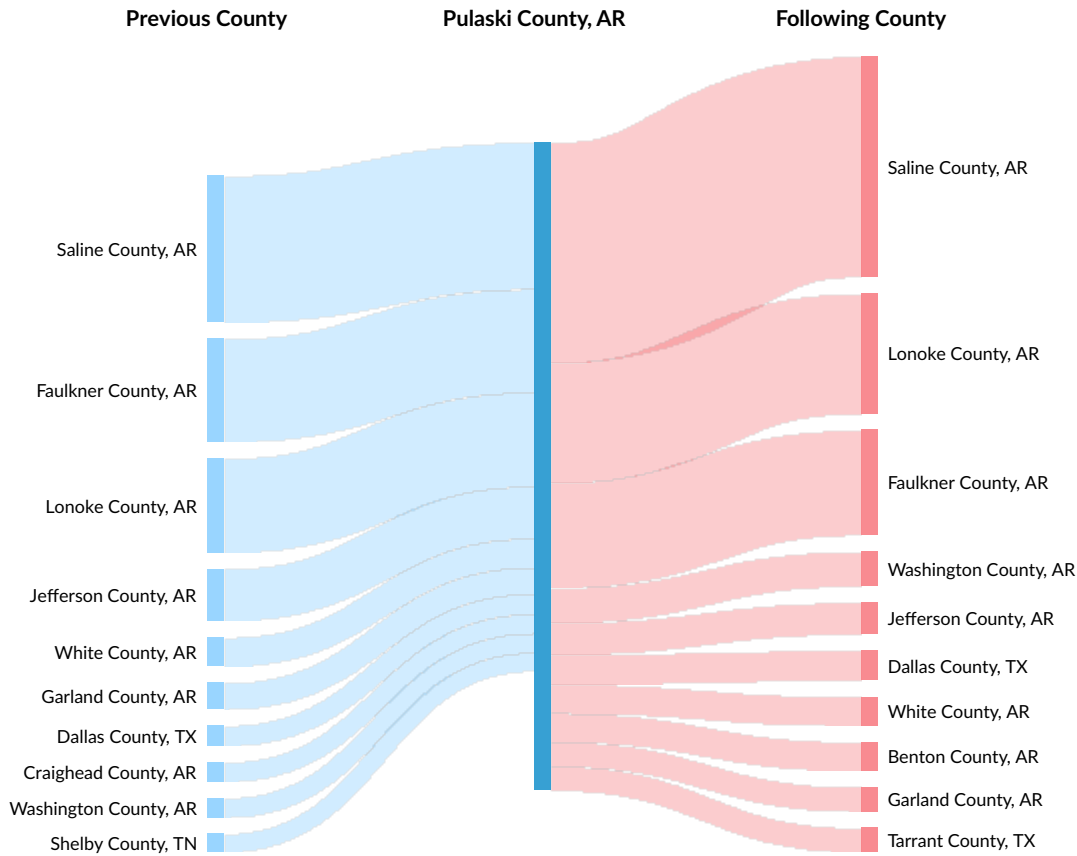


# Inbound and Outbound Migration
